

## **Introduction to preschool**

### **Information to you as guardian**

The preschool curriculum (Lpfö18) states:

“In order to create the best possible conditions for the children to be able to develop well and all-around, the preschool must cooperate in a close and trusting manner with the home.”

In Mora Municipality’s preschools, we use an active-parent introduction.

The objective of an active-parent introduction is:

- For the child to get used to the preschool’s environment together with the guardian.
- For the child to get to know at least one teacher well enough to feel safe when you as the guardian leave.
- For you as the guardian to get a complete picture of the preschool’s mission, care and education.

The preschool will contact you as the guardian to agree on the start of the introduction. Prior to the introduction, you as the guardian are invited to an information meeting at the preschool.

The number of days for the introduction is adjusted depending on the needs of the children. For at least three days, the child can participate in the daily activities together with you as the guardian, teachers and children at the unit.

Introduction times for the children who will have a 15-hour place are 9:00 a.m.-12:00 noon. For others, the introduction time is 9:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. on the first day, and 9:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m. on the other days.

We follow the regular routines during the introduction and guardians are involved and give the child security in each new element of care and teaching. During the introduction, you as a guardian are a secure base where you have an active role together with your child.

We expect you as the guardian to be available for one to two weeks in connection with the introduction.
